Restricted access area Unauthorised entry prohibited **Cultural heritage protection**

Visitors to Cathedral Cave must remain on the boardwalk.

To protect fragile rock art a restricted access area has been declared on each side of the boardwalk, as shown on the map.

Entry to the restricted access area is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence under the Nature Conservation Act 1992.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units. On-the-spot fines apply.

It is a serious offence under the Nature Conservation Act 1992 to interfere with a cultural resource such as Aboriginal rock art in a protected area.

Maximum penalty: 3000 penalty units.
