Restricted access area Unauthorised entry prohibited Cultural resource protection

Nukakurra restricted access area has been declared within Olkola National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) to protect significant cultural resources.

Entry to the area shown on the map and bound by symbols, is restricted.

A person, other than an acknowledged Olkola-Kurrumbila Traditional Owner, must not enter or remain in the restricted access area, without a permit or written approval from the Olkola Aboriginal Corporation.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*. Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units. On-the-spot fines apply
