

Restricted Access Area

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Cultural resource protection

A restricted access area has been declared over Egg Rock (Kurraragin), as shown on the map, to protect cultural heritage values.

Egg Rock (Kurraragin) has been identified as a significant Aboriginal area under the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act 2003*.

Entry to the area—including climbing, abseiling and all cliff and rope-based activities—is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

Contravention of the requirements of this notice is an offence against the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units.

On-the-spot fines apply.
