
DANGER

Dingoes roam this area Who is watching your catch and bait? You should be.

Be dingo-safe when fishing. You CAN make a difference.



• Use tightly sealed containers in your vehicle or in a shoulder bag.

Always dispose of fish offal correctly.

- Never clean fish at camp sites or townships.
- Never hang rubbish, bait and berley from trees, tents, or your vehicle.
- Bury offal at least 50cm deep and just below the high tide mark.
- Dingoes learn quickly. Don't clean fish or bury offal when they are around.



It is an offence to feed or make food available to a dingo, or intentionally attract or disturb dingoes. Penalties apply.
