

Restricted access area

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Public safety and conservation



Visitors must remain on the formed walking tracks and viewing platform.

A restricted access area has been declared over the rock pool, Cedar Creek and the surrounding area as shown in red on the map.

This is for the safety of visitors and the protection of glow-worm and platypus populations.

Entry to the restricted access area is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

Contravention of the requirements of this notice is an offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units.

On-the-spot fines apply.
