DANGER

Dingoes roam this area Who is watching your behaviour? You should be.

Be dingo-safe Never feed dingoes.

- Dingoes that get their food from people may become aggressive.
- Put food and rubbish away as soon as you are finished cooking or eating.
- Store food, iceboxes and rubbish bags in your vehicle, not in tents or hanging from trees

For your safety:

- Always stay within a couple of metres of your children.
- Always walk in pairs or groups, even for short distances.
- Never approach a dingo for any reason.
- Never go alone if bush toileting—take someone with you to watch for dingoes.



It is an offence to feed or make food available to a dingo, or intentionally attract or disturb dingoes. Penalties apply.

Pack food away.

Each small oversight makes dingoes less wary.
