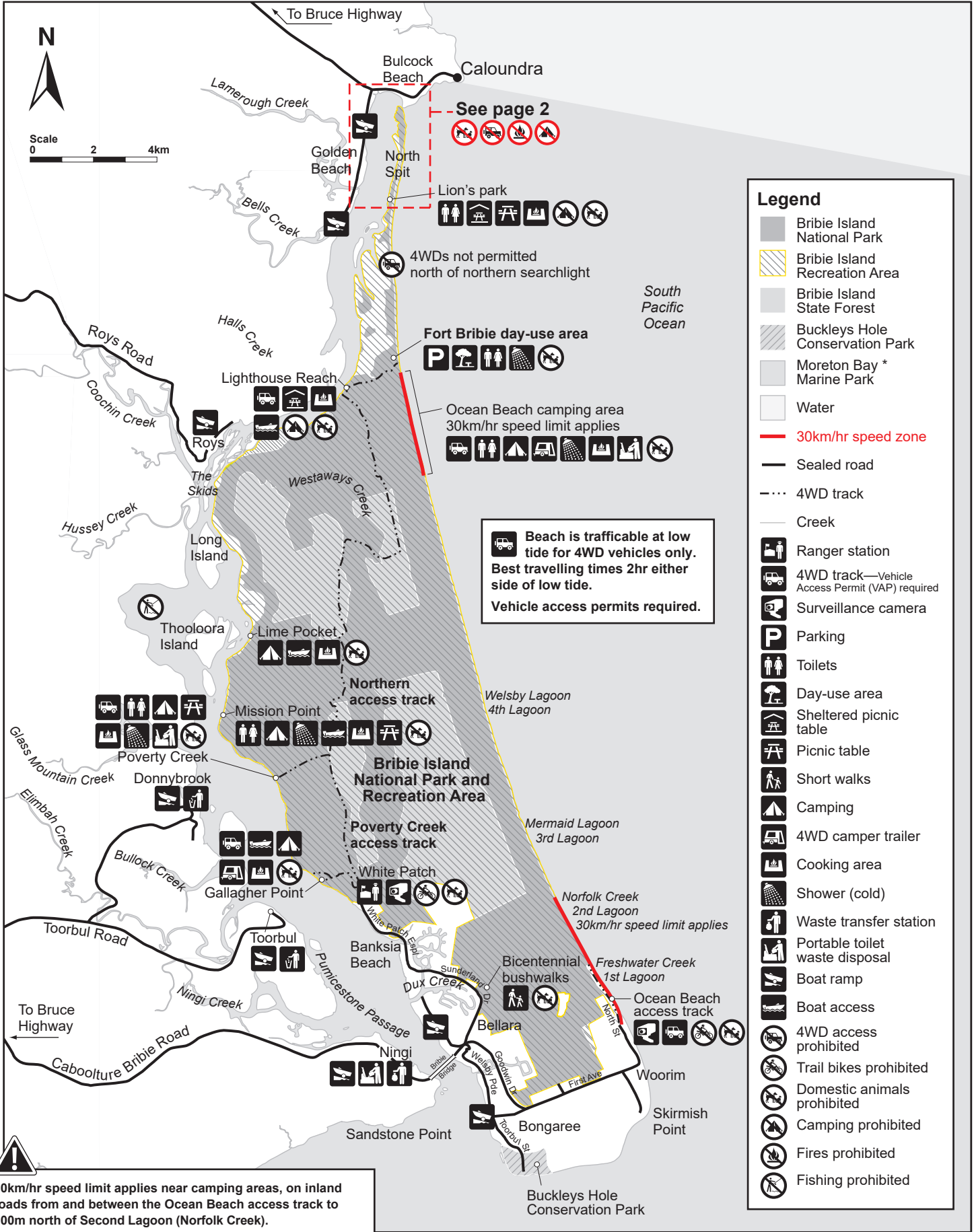


Bribie Island National Park and Recreation Area map

Fort Bribie day-use area

Ocean Beach camping area
30km/hr speed limit applies

Beach is trafficable at low tide for 4WD vehicles only. Best travelling times 2hr either side of low tide. Vehicle access permits required.

30km/hr speed limit applies near camping areas, on inland roads from and between the Ocean Beach access track to 300m north of Second Lagoon (Norfolk Creek).
50km/hr speed limit applies to all other beach travel.
Bribie Island Recreation Area boundary extends to mean low water mark.
