Restricted access area Unauthorised entry prohibited Cultural heritage protection


Visitors to the Art Gallery must remain on the formed track and boardwalk.

To protect fragile rock art a restricted access area has been declared on each side of the formed track and the boardwalk, as shown on the map.

Entry to the restricted access area is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units. On-the-spot fines apply.



It is a serious offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992* to interfere with a cultural resource such as Aboriginal rock art in a protected area.

Maximum penalty: 3000 penalty units.
