Restricted access area Unauthorised entry prohibited

Entry to Dinner Hole bora ground in Rinyirru (Lakefield) National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) (see map) is restricted to protect significant cultural resources.

A person, other than an acknowledged member of the Lama Lama Aboriginal people, must not enter or remain in this area without a permit or written approval from the Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS).

The restriction enables the Lama Lama Aboriginal people to protect and manage the cultural features and attributes of the area. This is a joint initiative between the Lama Lama Aboriginal people and QPWS.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence under the Nature Conservation Act 1992.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units. On-the-spot fines apply.
