To ensure you **book a suitable camp site**, see page 2–4 for **individual camp site details** (surface, size, shade, image).

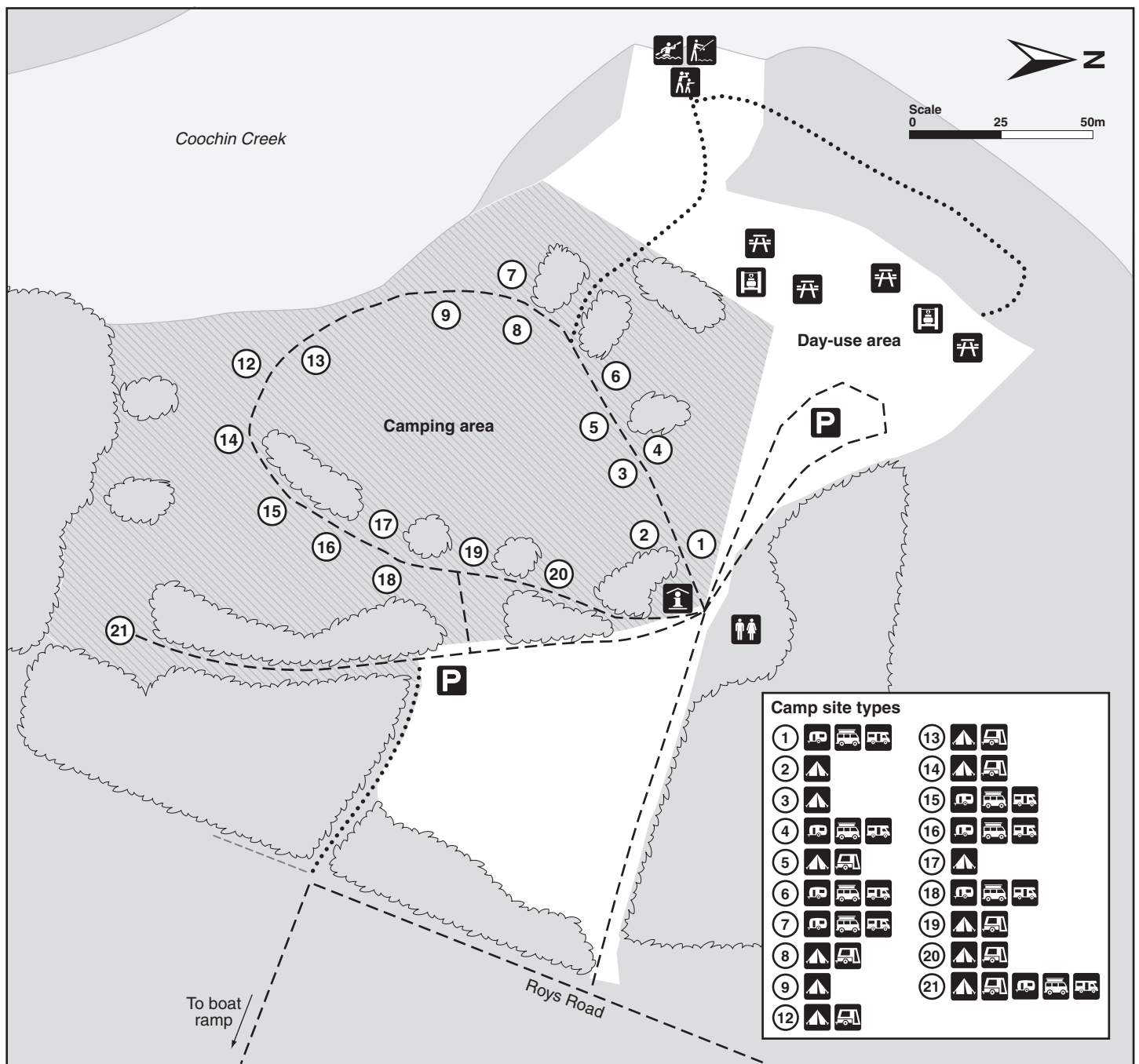

 Domestic animals are not permitted in the camping and day-use area.

 Generators are not permitted. Exemptions apply for medical purposes. For details visit qld.gov.au/NationalParks and search for Generator use medical exemptions.
