
Entry to Clack Island, Flinders Group National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) is restricted to protect cultural resources.


The restriction enables the Flinders Islands People and Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) to protect and manage the cultural values of the area.


A person, other than an acknowledged Flinders Islands Person, must not enter or remain in the restricted area shown on the map without a permit or written approval from QPWS.
