

Restricted access area

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Protection of cultural resources and property



Entry to the lipwulin Living Area (Ninian Bay), Cape Melville National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) is restricted to protect cultural resources and property (see map).

A person other than an acknowledged Gambil-mugu traditional owner, must not enter or remain in this area without a permit or written approval from the Cape Melville, Flinders and Howick Islands Aboriginal Corporation.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units.
On-the-spot fines apply.
