Restricted access area

Unauthorised entry prohibited Cultural heritage protection

Visitors to Madha (Mountain) rock art site must remain on the formed track and not go beyond the barrier.

- To protect fragile rock art a restricted access area has been declared, as shown on the map.
- Entry to the restricted access area is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units. On-the-spot fines apply.

It is a serious offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992* to interfere with a cultural resource such as Aboriginal rock art in a protected area. Maximum penalty: 3000 penalty units.
